STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Not Having a License Issued under Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 3060, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 3060 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 4 to read as follows:

4. Lack of license. Whoever is convicted of not having a license issued under chapters 301 to 335 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$20. If the cost of the license is more than \$20, the fine shall be not less than the cost of the license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to create uniformity for penalties regarding violations of the licensing statutes.
