AN ACT Extending Open Season on Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2355-A, amended. The first paragraph of section 2355-A of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 274 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

There shall be a closed season on bear from January 1st to ~~May 31st~~ **May 15th** in each calendar year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the purpose of this Act to extend open season on bear.
