Amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) by striking  
out the underlined figure "6" and inserting in place thereof the  
following underlined figure: '10'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment would place a limit of 10 on  
the number of dogs that hunters could use in hunting bear and  
partially control the dogs that are left behind in the fields or  
forests by departing hunters.
