**AN ACT Relating to Hunting Bear with Dogs.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2355-D, additional.** Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2355-D to read as follows:

**§ 2355-D. Hunting bear with dogs**

**It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons hunting together, to use more than 6 dogs at any one time for the purpose of hunting bear.**

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This would place a limit of 6 on the number of dogs that hunters could use in hunting bear and partially control the dogs that are left behind in the fields or forests by departing hunters.
