COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 90, L.D. 236, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Buying or Receiving Stolen
Property."

Amend said bill by striking out in the 5th line of
section 1 (4th line of L.D.) the figure "\$100" and inserting
in place thereof, the following: '~~\$100~~ \$500'.

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 5th line
of section 2 (4th line of L.D.) the figure "\$500" and inserting
in place thereof, the following: '~~\$500~~ \$1,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the maximum
fines in order to make them commensurate with the increased
property value figures.
