COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to S.P. 91, L.D. 237, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Appointment of Complaint Justices in the District Court."

Amend said bill in the 10th line (9th line of L. D.) by striking  
out the period after the underlined word "offenses" and inserting  
in place thereof, the following underlined words and punctuation:  
',to issue search warrants and to endorse certificates of commitment  
of the mentally ill, all in accordance with law, and to perform all  
other such acts and duties that are or may be authorized by law.'
