AN ACT Prohibiting Pony Pulling Contests.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1059, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1059 to read as follows:

§ 1059. Pony pulling contests prohibited

It shall be unlawful to permit or stage a performance known as "pony pulling contests." Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 60 days, or by both.
