HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 108, L. D. 253, RESOLVE,
Appropriating Funds to the Bath-Brunswick Mental Health Association
to Purchase a Facility for a Federally Funded Expanded Program.

Amend said Resolve by inserting at the end of the 6th
paragraph (same in L.D.) the following sentence:

'The above appropriation is contingent upon the receipt of
federal or other funds allowing the substantial expansion of
current services as proposed in the federal staffing grant
application.'
