HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 110, L.D. 255, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Eleven New Regions and Central Aroostook County Region for Vocational Education."

Amend said Bill in subsection 5 by inserting after the 4th sentence the following underlined sentences:

'Membership of the cooperative board shall be made up from the school administrative units in that area in proportion to the population of those administrative units. No single administrative unit shall have more than 50% of the total membership of the cooperative board.

Several small units may be jointly represented by a cooperative board member.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the membership of the cooperative board to be determined in proportion to the population of those administrative units in each area. No single administrative unit shall have more than 50% of the total membership of the cooperative board.
