STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Albert S. Herrick of Ellsworth for Boarding Stray Dogs.

Albert S. Herrick; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Dog Tax Account the sum of \$615 to reimburse Albert S. Herrick of Ellsworth as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for boarding stray dogs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

From October 7, 1968 to November 15, 1971, Mr. Herrick (Lamoine Kennel) provided food and shelter for 37 stray dogs. The Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 3406 states that the clerk of the respective municipality must be notified within 24 hours of the time the dog is received at the shelter. Inadvertently this was not done.
