RESOLVE, Discharging Town of Brooksville from Part of Indebtedness to State for Preparation of Agreement for Dissolution of School Administrative District No. 73.

Town of Brooksville, Hancock County; part of indebtedness discharged. Resolved: That all of the indebtedness, exceeding \$3,500, of the Town of Brooksville, Hancock County, for reimbursement for the expenses paid by the State in preparing the agreement of dissolution of School Administrative District No. 73, as provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 222, is hereby discharged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Town of Brooksville was informed that the expense of the dissolution of S.A.D. No. 73 to the town would be approximately 3,500. The town was presented a bill of 8,727.07. The town was never consulted or informed as to this excessive bill prior to its presentation and the discrepancy between the 2 figures is shocking.
