STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Repealing the Limited-user Highway Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 2068, repealed. Section 2068 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 240 of the public laws of 1967 and as amended is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Maine Supreme Judicial Court in Jordan v. Town of Canton, 265A. 2d 96 ruled that this law was unconstitutional because it took property for public uses without just compensation.
