STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Winter Maintenance of State Aid Highways and and Town Ways by Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 23, § 1005, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection 1 of section 1005 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 490 of the public laws of 1969, and as amended, is further amended to read as follows:
 - C. If the state valuation is more than \$750,000 but does not exceed \$7,000,000 \$1,500,000, the municipalities shall bear the first \$70 of cost per mile, and reimbursements shall be made to said municipalities in accordance with payrolls as submitted and approved; except that such reimbursement shall not exceed \$300 per mile.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to revise the reimbursement of towns having \$750,000 State valuation to \$1,500,000 State valuation rather than \$1,000,000 State valuation.
