IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Nonresident Hunting License Fee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2401, sub-§ 3, ¶¶ C, E and F, amended. Paragraphs C, E and F of subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section I of chapter 400 of the public laws of 1071, are amended to read as follows:

Junior nonresident hunting 10-16 years of age

\$12.50 \$15

- Permits hunting of all species except deer and bear. Application shall be accompanied by the written consent of his or her parent or guardian.
- E. Nonresident small game hunting Permits hunting of all species except bear and deer.

\$20.50 \$35

Nonresident big game hunting

\$42.50 \$65

Permits hunting for all species including bear and
