AN ACT Increasing Nonresident Hunting License Fee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2401, sub-§ 3, §§ C, E and F, amended. Paragraphs C, E and F of subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 409 of the public laws of 1971, are amended to read as follows:

10-16 years of age

| E. Nonresident small game hunting
Permits hunting of all species except bear and deer. | \$20.50 \$35 |
| F. Nonresident big game hunting
Permits hunting for all species including bear and
deer. | \$42.50 \$65 |
