AN ACT Relating to Military Service Credits Under Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1094, sub-§ 13, amended. The 2nd sentence of the first paragraph of subsection 13 of section 1094 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 449 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

A state employee shall be entitled to this credit only if at point of retirement he shall have at least ~~15~~ 10 years of creditable service in the State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to permit State employees to qualify for military service credit upon completion of 10 years of creditable service in the Maine State Retirement System rather than 15 years of service as the law presently provides. Although it would be impossible to predict with any degree of accuracy the cost of this change it is believed that such cost would be minimal.
