STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Designation of an Official in Absence or Disability of
Town Manager.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2314, amended. The first sentence of section 2314 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 438 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The town manager may designate a qualified administrative official of the municipality to perform his duties during his temporary absence or disability, subject to confirmation by the board of selectmen.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It seems reasonable that since the selectmen appoint the town manager, they should also approve of the person whom he chooses to take his place in the event of his absence or disability.
