**AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Death Caused by Violation of Law by  
Operator of Motor Vehicle.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 1316, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 1316 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any person convicted of such an offense shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~\$100~~ \$500 nor more than \$1,000 ~~or~~ and by imprisonment for not less than ~~30 days~~ 3 months nor more than 11 months ~~or by both.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would increase the penalty provisions of this section by increasing the fine and by requiring a jail sentence with a minimum length of 3 months.
