STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Recklessly Causing Death by Operation of a Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1315, amended. The 2nd sentence of the first paragraph of section 1315 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

Any person convicted of reckless homicide shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 \$2,000 or and by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or by both less than 6 months nor more than 5 years.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would increase the penalty provisions of this section and would make necessary a jail sentence and would set a minimum jail sentence.
