# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance Under the State Retirement Law for Mildred Beryl Foss of Lincoln.

Mildred Beryl Foss of Lincoln; retirement allowance. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, Mildred Beryl Foss of Lincoln shall receive the minimum retirement allowance for 10 years service as provided under the State Retirement Law.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Present law permits \$80 per month to any person who has 10 years of creditable service but also required that any part of this time must be membership service rendered after July 1, 1942. Mrs. Foss was employed in the Bangor State Hospital from September 1928 until May 1942 and separated before the law took effect and as she is now over age 70 cannot become reemployed and cannot qualify for this benefit by becoming a contributing member.
