STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Original Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2241, amended. The 2nd sentence of the last paragraph of section 2241 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 118 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

If a person is convicted of a motor vehicle moving violation while in the possession of a provisional license on the first offense, the license shall be suspended for 30 days; except that if such person proves to the satisfaction of the Secretary of State that the license is necessary for such person to retain his employment, such license shall be permitted for use by such person in traveling to and from his place of employment and in performing the duties of his employment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the original motor vehicle license of a person who has been convicted of a motor vehicle moving violation on the first offense to be used for that person's employment.
