CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 206,
L. D. 279, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Burglary."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: 'When a person is convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for a violation of any of the provisions of this section and such violation occurred at a time when said person was on bail in connection with a prior violation of this section, the sentence imposed for said 2nd offense shall not be served concurrently with any sentence imposed in connection with said first offense.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: 'When a person is convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for a violation of any of the provisions of this section and such violation occurred at a time when said person was on bail in connection with a prior violation of any provision of this section, the sentence imposed for said 2nd offense shall not be served concurrently with any sentence imposed in connection with said first offense.'
