**AN ACT Relating to Effective Date of Salary Increases of County Officers.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 30, § 3, amended.** Section 3 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**§ 3. —increases**

Increases in the salaries of county officers, authorized by the Legislature, shall ~~not~~ become effective ~~until~~ January 1st of the year ~~next succeeding the recess of the convening~~ of the session of the Legislature passing such salary increases.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

County officers must wait one year for salary increase authorized by the Legislature. Non-statutory county employees are eligible for pay increases within a line budget on a yearly basis.
