## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

### AN ACT Relating to Effective Date of Salary Increases of County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 3, amended. Section 3 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

### § 3. —increases

Increases in the salaries of county officers, authorized by the Legislature, shall not become effective until January 1st of the year next succeeding the recess of the convening of the session of the Legislature passing such salary increases.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

County officers must wait one year for salary increase authorized by the Legislature. Non-statutory county employees are eligible for pay increases within a line budget on a yearly basis.
