**RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance under the  
State Retirement Law for Miss Mildred Keene.**

---

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 105th Legislature in regular session provided for a minimum service retirement allowance for state employees and teachers of \$80 per month, if the member had 10 years of creditable service at retirement; and

Whereas, Miss Mildred Keene retired prior to the effective date of such law; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to provide Miss Mildred Keene a minimum service retirement allowance of \$80 per month; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

**Miss Mildred Keene; creditable teaching service. Resolved:** That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to credit Miss Mildred Keene with 10 years of teaching service upon verification of creditable service, thereby permitting her to receive the minimum service retirement allowance of \$80 per month as provided under the State Retirement Law, provided that she remit to such system an amount equal to that contribution which would have been deducted from her com-

pensation if she had been employed for 10 years in teaching service. Such amount shall be computed by the Board of Trustees of the Retirement System.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Miss Mildred Keene retired prior to the effective date when the \$80 minimum service retirement allowance became effective. The purpose of this resolve is to provide her with a retirement allowance to the minimum now authorized by law.
