HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 223, L. D. 296, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Feasibility Study for a Turnpike Facility from Houlton to Van Buren."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the title the words "Van Buren" and inserting in place thereof the words 'the Northern Boundary of Maine'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line (3rd and 4th in the L. D.) the words "Towns of Houlton and Van Buren" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'Town of Houlton and the northern boundary of Maine'

The purpose of this amendment is to make the northern terminal the boundary of northern Maine instead of Van Buren.
