HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 223, L.D. 296, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Feasibility Study for a Turnpike Facility from Houlton to Van Buren."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word
"Van Buren" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Fort Kent'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line of "Sec. 1." (same in L.D.) by striking out the word "Van Buren" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Fort Kent'

Further amend said Bill in the 2nd line of "Sec. 2." (same in L.D.) by striking out the figures "\$50,000" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$60,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to determine the feasibility of locating, constructing and operating a turnpike toll facility connecting points north of Houlton with the present Interstate highway system. The total estimated cost of this proposal is \$60,000.
