SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 128, L. D. 305, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Working Capital of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages."

Amond said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'<u>Frencency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the tourist season in Maine is about to begin; and Whereas, in order to provide funds for the working capital of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to take care of the tourist business in Maine for this summer; and

Whences, it is vitally necessary that the following legislation be enacted as soon as possible; and

Wheneas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill in the last line of the first paragraph (same in T. D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$5,000,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$4,500,000'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

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Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill and to change the working capital of the Eureau of Alcoholic Beverages from \$5,000,000 to \$4,500,000.
