STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Working Capital of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 56, amended. The 5th sentence of section 56 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Commissioner of Finance and Administration is authorized to increase the permanent working capital of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Due to increased sales and costs of merchandise, it is necessary to have this additional fund to properly maintain the inventory of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.
