AN ACT Prohibiting Smoking on Public Conveyances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, §3954-A, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3954-A to read as follows:

§ 3954-A. Smoking in public conveyances

It is unlawful for any person to smoke or cause smoke to be manufactured on any public conveyance unless air conditioning is provided or a separate area is set off and designated for such purpose. Violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The full intent of this Act is reflected in the title.
