HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 230, L. D. 310, Bill, "AN  
ACT Revising the Maine Egg Grading Law."

Amend said bill in section 4 by adding at the end the  
following underlined sentence: 'In the establishment of such  
grades, the commissioner shall consult an advisory committee  
of 5 appointed by him, 3 of whom shall be chosen from a list  
submitted by the Maine Poultry Improvement Association.'

grades.
