**AN ACT Limiting the Number of Lobster Traps Per Person in York County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4468, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4468 to read as follows:

§ 4468. —York County

It is unlawful for any person to set more than 400 lobster traps per boat at any one time in any of the tidal waters of York County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the number of lobster traps per person in York County to 400.
