AN ACT Relating to the Use of Power Boats on Sandy Pond, Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 250, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 250 to read as follows:

§ 250. —Sandy Pond, Waldo County; use of power boats

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on Sandy Pond, Towns of Freedom and Montville, Waldo County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect the tranquility and ecology of a small, shallow pond.
