AN ACT Relating to General Purpose Education Aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3731, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 3731 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 496 of the public laws of 1969, and as amended, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

From the aid computed for each unit there shall be deducted a sum of money which shall be paid directly to the superintendent of schools under sections 154 and 155. This sum shall be equal to 40% of the salary of each superintendent of schools and shall be paid by the State from the allocation of the unit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide authorization for continuation of direct payment of a portion of a superintendent of school's salary to each superintendent. A similar provision has been in effect since 1917 but will expire June 30, 1973, unless authorization is extended. Payment is made from an administrative unit's subsidy allocation. No additional cost to the State or local unit is involved.
