STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Medical and Other Personnel in Certain Industries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 45, amended. Section 45 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 446 of the public laws of 1971, and as amended by section 13 of chapter 620 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

All industries employing over 100 employees and maintaining 2nd and 3rd work shifts are obliged to maintain qualified medical personnel on all shifts. The gates and entrances to such industries are to have qualified personnel on duty at all times to insure traffic flow during emergencies.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide medical and other personnel in industries having more than 100 employees and maintaining more than one shift.
