COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 243, L. D. 325, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Tribal Elections, Governor and Council  
of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"§ 4793." by striking out all of the last underlined sentence  
of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'No member of the council shall be liable to answer for anything  
spoken in debate at any council meeting.'
