COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 248, L.D. 328, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing the West Bath Game Sanctuary."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in place thereof the following underlined
paragraph:

'West Bath Game Sanctuary: No person shall at any time hunt,
trap, catch, pursue, shoot at or kill any wild animal or bird within
the following described territory situated in the Town of West Bath
in the County of Sagadahoc: Beginning at a place known as Berry's
Mill, so called; thence running in a southerly direction along the
Berry's Mill Road to Prince's Corner, so called; thence southerly
by the Campbell Pond Road and the Meadowbrook Road to the Phippsburg
town line; thence along the town line to low, low water mark on the
shore of Brigham's Cove in Winnegance Bay; thence southerly by low,
low water mark and westerly by low, low water mark to Birch Point;
thence northerly by low, low water mark and easterly by low, low
water mark along the New Meadows River and Mill Cove to the point
of beginning.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to more definitely describe
the West Bath Game Sanctuary.
