AN ACT Relating to Animal Disease Appraisal and Indemnity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 7, § 1756, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1756 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Maximum indemnity payments shall be determined by the commissioner, taking into consideration indemnities paid by the United States Department of Agriculture on domestic animals condemned in cooperative eradication programs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Recent changes in meat inspection procedures relating to condemned animals and changes of indemnities by United States Department of Agriculture in cooperative eradication programs make it necessary to be able to establish indemnities as occasion may require.
