SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H. P. 257, L. D. 337, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying the Law as to
Keeping Wild Animals in Captivity."

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end of the
2nd paragraph, before the period, the following:

' , except that a person may keep a wild animal if said animal
was purchased or obtained originally, from a dealer, pet shop
or licensed roadside menagerie. No person shall keep a wild
animal captured in its natural habitat unless said animal
has been certified as being free from disease by a duly
licensed veterinarian or the Commissioner of Agriculture or
the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment will allow people to keep
so-called wild animals as pets as long as they are free from
disease.
