COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 257, L.D. 337, Bill, "AN ACT
Clarifying the Law as to Keeping Wild Animals in Captivity."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in place
thereof, the following:

'No person shall keep in captivity any wild animal for any
purpose, except in accordance with this section, section 2106 and
Title 7, section 1809.'
