STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Free Hunting and Fishing Licenses to Domiciled Maine Veterans 65 Years of Age or Older.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2401-B, sub-§ 15-A, additional. Section 2401-B of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 409 of the public laws of 1971 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 15-A to read as follows:
- 15-A. Complimentary licenses to Maine veterans 65 years of age or older. A complimentary license to hunt and fish shall be issued to any Maine veteran domiciled in Maine who is 65 years of age or older and applies therefor to the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.
