AN ACT to Permit Municipalities to Collect a Fee for Lodging House Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2756, amended. The last sentence of section 2756 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The fee for a lodging house license shall not exceed \$10 for lodging houses with 10 rooms or less and \$25 for lodging houses with more than 10 rooms.
