COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 133, L. D. 345, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fines Levied by the Harness Racing Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In order to maintain proper control of harness racing,
the commission is authorized to establish a schedule of fines
not to exceed \$50, which may be levied, in lieu of suspension,
for the violation of the rules of racing as designated by the
commission.

Any party aggrieved by any action taken pursuant to this section may petition the Administrative Hearing Commissioner for a declaratory ruling under Title 5, section 2402.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to supply the commission with a minor penalty to impose for minor violations of the rules of racing when a suspension of a license for even one day would be considered harsh and to provide an appeal procedure before the Administrative Hearing Commissioner.
