HOUSE AMENDMENT" B " S.P. 136, L.D. 348, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Apportionment of Cost of Reconstruction of Railroad
Grade Separation Structures on Nonfederal Aid-State Aid Highways."

Amend said bill by inserting after section 3, the following:

'Sec. 4. Application. For the purposes of the Revised
Statutes, Title 23, section 53 and this legislation, the North
Street Bridge in Waterville, including the approaches thereto, shall
be included in the second classification, state-aid highways.

The cost of reconstruction of the North Street Bridge in
Waterville shall be apportioned as above, 80% to the Department of
Transportation, 10% to the Railroad Corporation and 10% to the
municipality having jurisdiction of the road in question, notwith-
standing any power given to the Department of Transportation to
vary an apportionment.'

Further amend said bill by renumbering section 4 to be section
5.

The purpose of the amendment is to include North Street Bridge,
Waterville, in the 2nd classification.
