AN ACT Relating to Membership in State Board of Licensure of
Administrators of Medical Care Facilities other than Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 63, sub-§ 1, amended. The first sentence of subsection 1 of section 63 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 350 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

There shall be a State Board of Licensure of Administrators of Medical Care Facilities other than Hospitals consisting of ~~7~~ 8 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 63, sub-§ 1, amended. The next to the last sentence of subsection 1 of section 63 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 350 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

~~One member~~ **Two members** shall be ~~a representative~~ **representatives** of the public.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 32, § 63, sub-§ 2, amended. The last sentence of subsection 2 of section 63 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 350 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed as follows:

~~A member shall not be appointed for more than 2 consecutive full terms.~~
