HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 290, L.D. 364, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Deer Doing Damage to Blueberry Lands.

Amend said Bill in the 5th line (same in L.D.) by striking
out the words and punctuation "including legumes," and inserting
in place thereof the following: '~~including-legumes,~~'

Further amend said Bill in the 5th line (same in L.D.) by
inserting after the word "grass" the following underlined words
and punctuation: ', clover, grain fields '

deer in grain fields and clover.
