**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor for
Property Damage by Highway Maintenance.**

Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved:
That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,378.40 to be paid to Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation for damage to cemetery fence caused by snow plowing operations.

STATEMENT OF FACT

A very substantial and expensive fence fronting Mount Hope Cemetery on the Maine State Highway leading from Bangor to Orono was damaged in the winter season of 1971 by the snow plowing operations of the Maine State Highway Commission. Between the unusually heavy snowfall and the necessity of winging back the snow to make room for other storm accumulations, the pressure caused thereby bent back the fence causing considerable damage for which this claim is made.
