HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 266, L. D. 373, Bill,  
"AN ACT Converting Great Pond Plantation into the Town of Great  
Pond.

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Legislative district. Until the next legislative  
apportionment of Representatives, the Town of Great Pond shall  
remain in the same legislative district in which Great Pond  
Plantation is now classed.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 3 to be  
section 4.
