**AN ACT Relating to Obtaining Absentee Ballot When Voter Will Be Absent
from the Municipality.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1253, sub-§ 5, additional. Section 1253 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 5 to read as follows:

5. When voter to be absent from municipality. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who will be absent from the municipality on election day must apply in person for an absentee ballot from the clerk.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that a person who will be absent from the municipality on election day must apply for an absentee ballot in person.
