COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " H.P. 274, L.D. 380, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Control of Outdoor Advertising."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and before the Emergency Clause, and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'R.S., T. 32, §2716, sub-§ 2, amended. The first paragraph of
subsection 2 of section 2716 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes,
as enacted by section 1 of chapter 257 of the public laws of 1969,
is amended to read as follows:

No person, firm or corporation shall erect or maintain any
legible advertisement that can be seen from any portion of the
Interstate System, including ramps and interchange areas, or any
portion of the primary system or any portion of a scenic highway
and no ~~No~~ person, firm or corporation shall erect or maintain
within 660 feet of the nearest right-of-way boundary line of any
portion of the Interstate System, including ramps and interchange
areas or any portion of the primary system or any portion of a
scenic highway, any advertising structure or advertisement of any
kind except:'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to include ramps and interchange areas to
the areas where no person or corporation shall erect advertising
signs.
